SECOND SCHEDULING ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the Court for a Status Conference on September 2, 2021 [ECF No. 59]. Having reviewed, discussed, and considered all items on the Parties' Joint Proposed Agenda [ECF No. 58-1], the Court hereby directs the parties to adhere to the following schedule:

Joint Motion to Dismiss: Defendants' joint motion to dismiss is due **September 20, 2021** and shall not exceed **60 pages**. Plaintiffs' response in opposition to Defendants' joint motion to dismiss is due **October 20, 2021** and shall not exceed **60 pages**. Defendants' reply in support of their joint motion to dismiss is due **November 19, 2021** and shall not exceed **30 pages**.

Motion to Stay Discovery and Existing Stay: Defendants shall file their motion to stay discovery on **September 20, 2021**. Plaintiffs' response in opposition to Defendants' motion to stay discovery is due **September 27, 2021**. Defendants' reply in support of their motion to stay discovery is due **October 4, 2021**. The existing stay of discovery imposed by the Court in Pretrial Order No. 1, [ECF No. 12] at 4, is hereby extended until the Court enters a ruling on Defendants' forthcoming motion to stay discovery.

Conference Report: The deadline for submitting a Conference Report as required by Local Rule 16.1(b)(2) is hereby extended until the Court enters a ruling on Defendants' forthcoming motion to stay discovery.

Status Conference: The parties shall attend a status conference on **October 4, 2021 at 11:00 AM**. The conference will be held via video conference, with instructions to follow. The parties shall submit a joint proposed agenda listing items for discussion at the October status conference by **September 29, 2021**.
