FOURTH SCHEDULING ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the Court for a Status Conference on November 15, 2021 [ECF No. 74]. Following an unopposed *ore tenus* motion for extension of time by counsel for Defendant Mednax, the Court hereby directs the parties to adhere to the following revised schedule:

Joint Motion to Dismiss: Defendants' joint motion to dismiss is due **January 6, 2022** and shall not exceed **60 pages**. Plaintiffs' response in opposition to Defendants' joint motion to dismiss is due **February 7, 2022** and shall not exceed **60 pages**. Defendants' reply in support of their joint motion to dismiss is due **March 7, 2022** and shall not exceed **30 pages**.

Status Conference: As discussed at the Status Conference [ECF No. 74], the hearing previously scheduled for November 19, 2021 is hereby cancelled. *See* [ECF No. 69]. The parties shall instead attend a status conference on **December 15, 2021 at 1:00 PM**. The conference will be held via video conference, with instructions to follow. The parties shall submit a joint proposed agenda listing items for discussion at the December status conference by **December 10, 2021**.
