DISCOVERY ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the Court for a Status Conference via Zoom on January 20, 2023 [ECF No. 164], during which the Court heard argument on Plaintiffs' *ore tenus* motion to expand electronically stored information ("ESI") search parameters. *See* Paperless Order [ECF No. 165]. Following the Status Conference, the Court granted in part and denied in part Plaintiffs' *ore tenus* motion and required the parties to submit a proposed order formalizing the at-issue ESI search parameters. *See id.* Having heard the parties' arguments, and after review of the record and the parties' submission, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

- 1. Defendants Mednax Inc.; Mednax Services, Inc.; Pediatrix Medical Group; and Pediatrix Medical Group of Kansas, P.C.'s (collectively "Mednax") shall apply a date filter of **June 1, 2019 through May 1, 2022** to the following search term: HHS OR (OCR w/20 (HIPPA OR HITECH OR secur* OR cyber* OR data* OR investigat* OR inquir*)) OR "Office of Civil Rights" OR "Attorney General" OR AG.
- 2. Mednax shall apply a date filter of **June 1, 2019 through December 22, 2020** to all other search terms the parties have agreed Mednax will use to conduct its review of documents that are not being reviewed pursuant to the expedited review of certain documents. *See* [ECF Nos. 154, 158].

3. This Order is without prejudice to Plaintiffs' ability to move to expand the applicable timeframes upon a proper showing.
